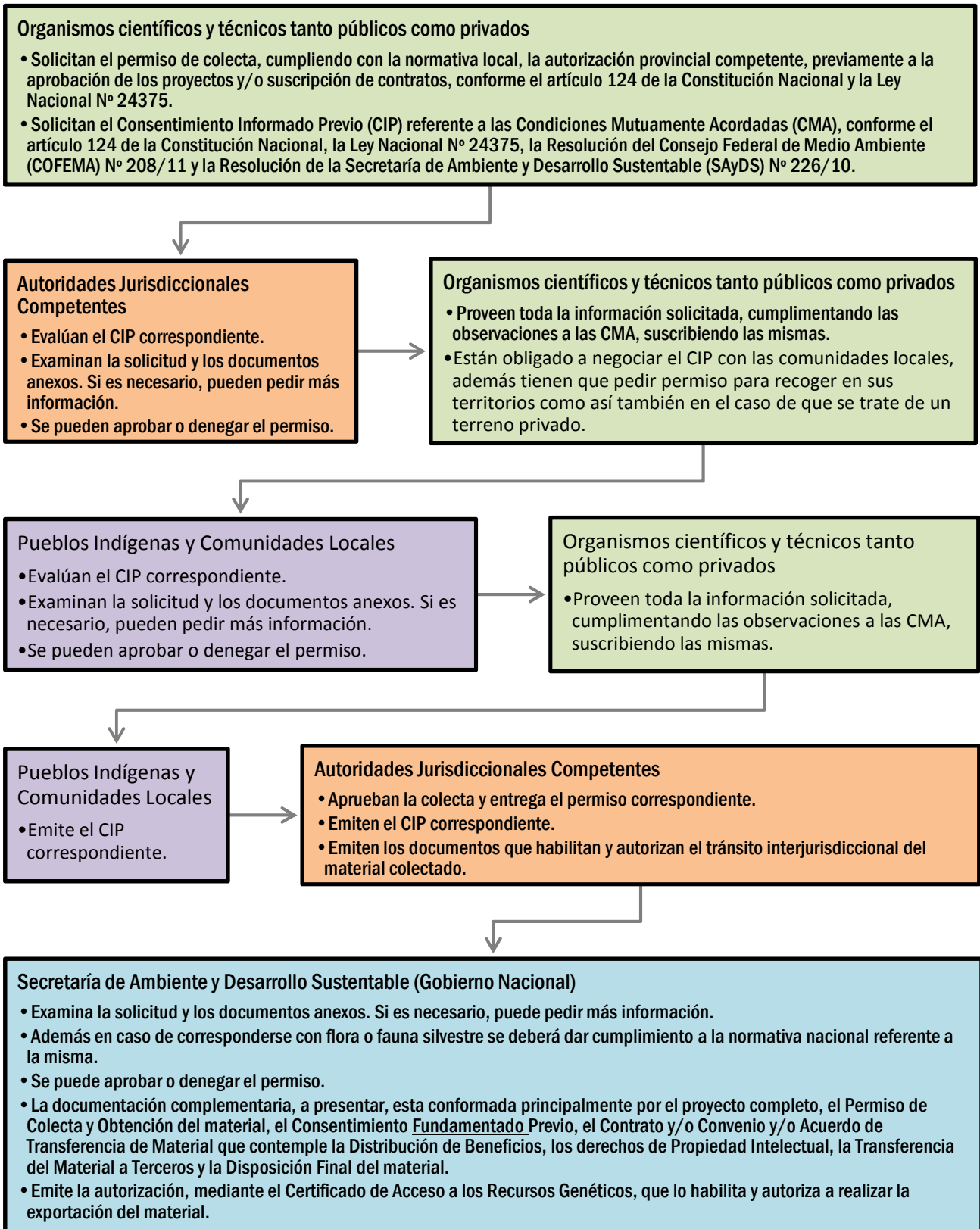

This document presents the step-by-step application process for access to genetic resources with (diagram 1) or without (diagram 2) associated Traditional Knowledge in Argentina.

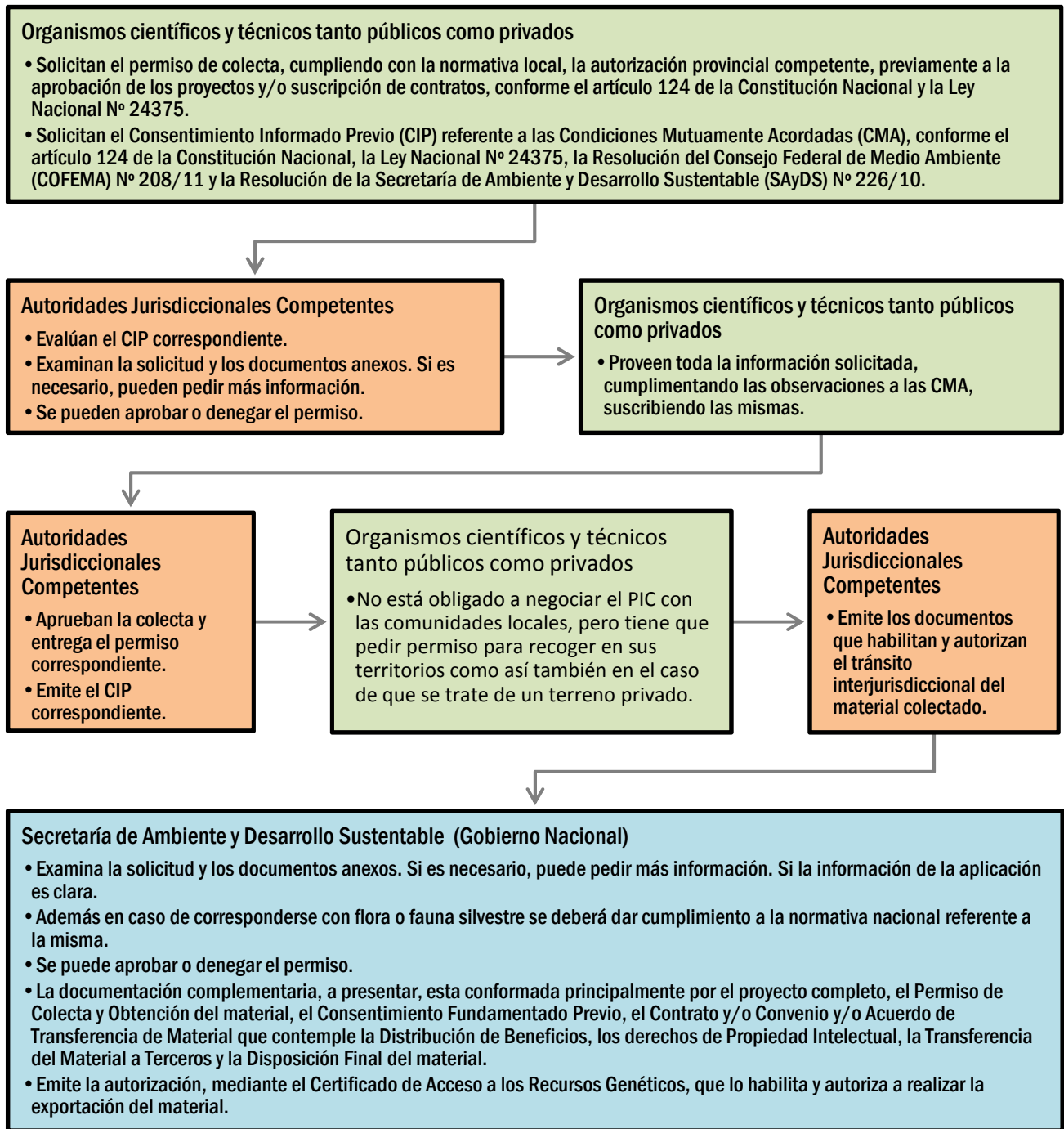

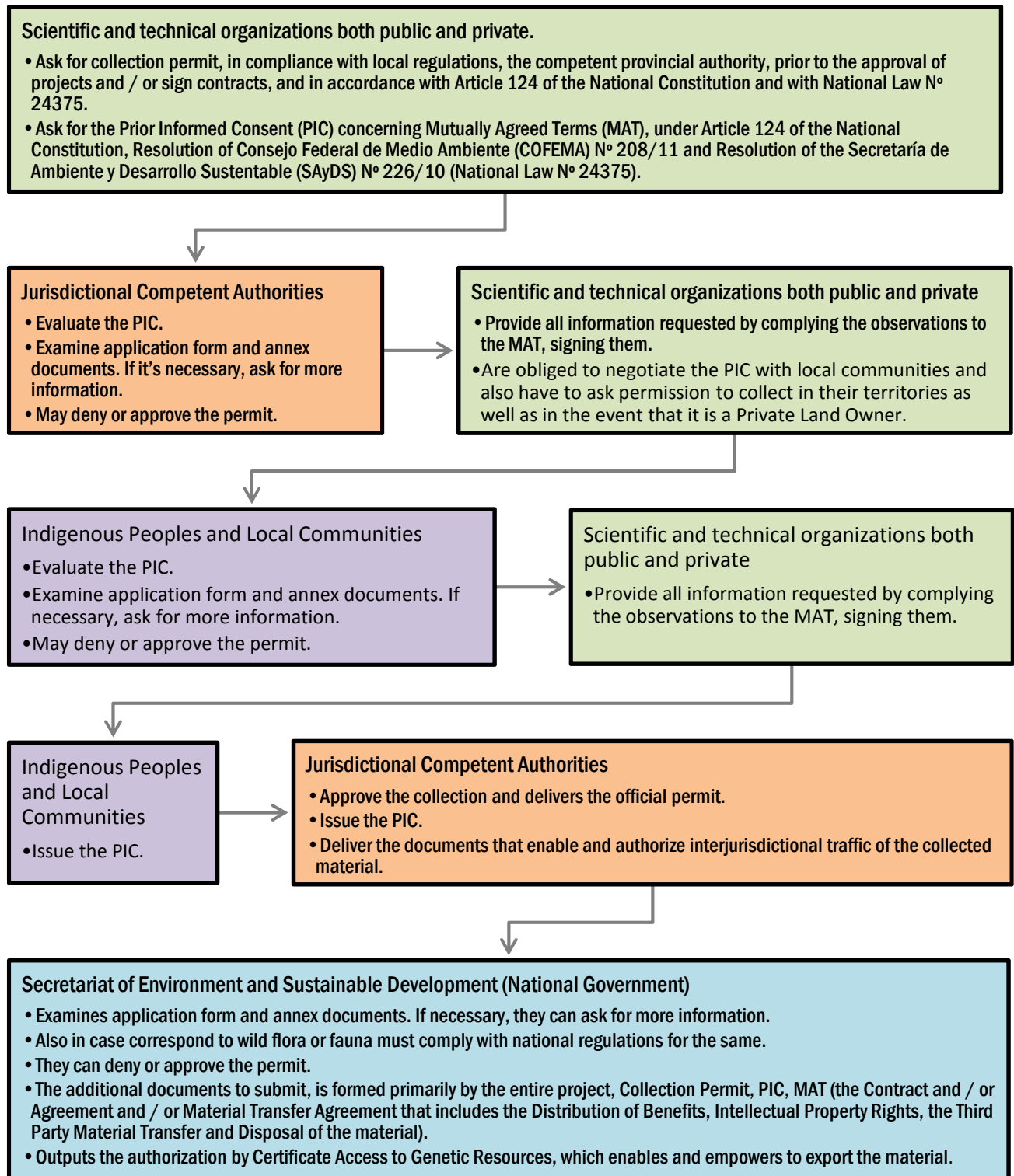
**Diagrama 1: Caso de acceso *in situ* para la investigación con Conocimiento Tradicional**
